



**Tuolumne-Stanislaus Integrated  
Regional Water Management Authority  
2021-2023 Fiscal Years Accomplishments**

- ✓ \$525,000 awarded for DAC projects to include a water fill station through GCSD and well testing through ATCAA
- ✓ \$292,000 awarded to ATCAA for the Low Income Household Water Conservation program
- ✓ \$5M awarded for THCSO million-gallon tank, Tuolumne Rancheria potable water tank and water line improvements
- ✓ ATCAA Home-Level Water Conservation project for \$1.6M closed out
- ✓ TUD Phoenix Lake project for \$5.1M closed out
- ✓ THCSO Water Supply Reliability Wells project for \$750,000 closed out
- ✓ TCRCO Small Parcel Storm Water Pollution Prevention and Landowner Stewardship Program for \$240,000 and the Regional Water Conservation Program for \$3.5M closed out
- ✓ UTICA Communications grant for \$40,000 closed out
- ✓ Completed the DAC Assessment Report utilizing almost 1,700 surveys
- ✓ A stand-alone ESRI GIS account was purchased for data management
- ✓ Outreach Subcommittee created and distributed a “Drought Education” handout and evaluated website and data management needs
- ✓ Held multiple “Calls for Projects” for IRWMA Plan inclusion which added: Amended THCSO Storm Water Project, TUD Phoenix Lake Phase 2, TUD Mt. Provo Water Transmission and Intertie, TUD Sonora Water Treatment Plant Modernization Project, GCSD Drought Resilience Project, GCSD Downtown Groveland/Big Oak Flat Water Distribution Replacement Project, GCSD Advance Metering Infrastructure Development Project, THCSO Sherwood Forest Collection System and Twain Harte Collections System Improvement Project, THCSO Shadybrook Reservoir Silt Removal, T-Stan IRWMA Regional Turf Replacement Program, and JSD Wastewater Facility Upgrades #1
- ✓ \$15M grant was submitted for THCSO Water Loss Reduction Program, THCSO Shadybrook Reservoir Capacity Restoration, Tuolumne Band Westside Dam

Rehabilitation/Tuolumne Log Pond Dam Spillway Upgrade Project, and GCSD  
Advanced Metering Infrastructure Installation

- ✓ \$7M grant submitted for regional turf replacement
- ✓ The IRWMA continues to self-fund operations and carry a reserve
